

COUNSELING

CCA COUNSELING POLICY

FOR THE FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL

YOU CAN SEE YOUR COUNSELOR ONLY IF

- You do not have a class schedule.
- You don't have a class this period.
- You are a 12th grade student who needs a course for graduation.

BEFORE SCHOOL, PASSING PERIOD, LUNCH AND AFTER SCHOOL,

YOU CAN SUBMIT AN ADD/DROP FORM WITH PARENT SIGNATURE ONLY IF

- You want to **drop a class. You will submit an add/drop form and return to class.**
- You want to **request a level change** (AP/Honors to college prep or vice versa). **You will submit an add/drop form and return to class.**
- You want to **add an academic course for college eligibility. You will submit an add/drop form and return to class.**
- **Same period elective change requests can be made via add/drop form Wed. 8/31-Fri. 9/2 only.**

You can return ONLY before school, at lunch or after school to get a new schedule if a change is made or retrieve your add/drop form to follow up.

YOU CANNOT VISIT THE COUNSELING OFFICE IF

- You want to request that a class be in a specific period or term, including for athletics.
- You want to request to change your teacher.
- You want to discuss spring term classes.

FROM ADMINISTRATION

- Students- Beginning this school year, you MUST attend a Start Smart driving program to be eligible to purchase a parking permit to park on campus in the designated student lot! If you haven't already signed up for a class, please visit the CCA website at <http://www.sduhsd.net/cc/documents/Start%20Smart.PDF> for more details. Beginning the first week of October, campus security and Administration will begin ticketing cars without permits or parked in the incorrect lots. Please purchase a parking permit if you have not already done so and park in the correct lot. Thank you for your cooperation and support as we continue to make CCA a safe place for all students.
