- **OFF CAMPUS Courses:** This is a reminder for all students that are planning to take a course off campus. You MUST submit an [Off-Campus Course Permission Form](#) PRIOR to starting the course. It must be filled out completely, including all applicable signatures (student, counselor, registrar, and parent). After completion of the course it is your responsibility to have an official transcript sent directly to the CCA Registrar. The registrar will only accept official transcripts. Check the counseling page to view additional information about Off Campus classes & to print out the form.

- **NCAA:** To request a transcript be sent to the Eligibility Center come to the Registrar's Office. The NCAA requires that you send separate transcripts for course work taken at another school or for any course that you took off campus. If you attended another school within the SDUHSD, you do NOT need to send a separate transcript.
