You are not obligated to purchase this concert attire, but we ask that students all appear as uniform as possible to present a very professional appearance at our performances. The dress style that the students selected is a wide strapped scoop neck dress with an empire waist long black dress and ties in the back to further adjust the fit. There will also be a black velvet bolero style jacket to wear with it. The material of the dress is poly microfiber and is machine washable. The sizing of the dress may be different than regular clothes sizing and specific measurements are required to assure the best fit:
