We DO supply your child with everything they need to complete all assignments, but materials tend to 'walk out' of class with some students, and then we quickly run low on supplies. Your student is in an advanced/college level art class, and if this is because your student wants to be a serious artist, then it is best that they have art supplies at home. Also,

your student may wish to have a personal supply of good quality materials to use in class. Below is a very inexpensive list of things that you can locally buy. Your student can then carry the supplies in their backpack or keep them in an 'art box' in class.

You should not have to spend more than \$20 – 30 for the basics!!!

- **USB Port** (Flash Drive)
 - Estimated cost: \$15 on up!
 - You will need this to store images of your work on – the AP Portfolio is now DIGITAL!
- **Portfolio**
 - Estimated Cost: \$ 7 – 14 – 30 - as much as you want to pay!
 - This is a bit more expensive, but if your child is creating amazing art then they need to have a place to keep this art safe. Also, they will be bringing art back and forth from home to school.
